The economics of fluoridation.

Abstract

The available data has been used to assess the maximum economic level of expenditure on fluoridation of the water supply. Discounting has been carried out to allow the comparison of expenditure incurred and savings which accrue at different times. Sources of supply with yields of one million gallons per day or more are likely to be economic to fluoridate but very small sources may be too expensive to justify the installation of plant.
